**REPORT ON THE CELEBRATION OF NATIONAL AND INTERNATIONAL COMMEMORATIVE
DAYS,EVENTS AND FESTIVALS**

Usually academic calendar of the college has been framed giving provision of celebrating Martyr's Day, NSS Day and Gandhi Jayanti by staffs and students in every academic year. Likely Patriots Day a state function (13th August) has been continuously celebrating for several years. Celebration of NSS Day has been amalgamated with extension lecture programmes delivered by many experts on various social and national issues etc. It can be assumed that celebration of these days will help feel the sense of dedication by the students to nation's security, unity and development.

Other national and international days viz, World Ozone Day, World Food Day, World Environment Day and Teachers Day have been also observed in the college for dissemination of relevant messages and significances of observation in present days and to follow up thereon. Particularly about Teachers Day, it is to report that the observation is being organized solely by students voluntarily to render respect to teachers acknowledging their dedicative service for building up of the nation.

Mention may be made that the college does not observe World Environment Day by merely delivering speech by teachers but with plantation of trees by staffs, students and members of Alumni Association and subsequent nurturing. The speakers of World Food Day emphasized much about reduction of food wastage in connection with elimination of hunger of poor people, organic farming and establishment of food industries based on availability local raw materials etc. Every participant of observation of World Ozone Day had been advised to take up measures to reduce release of ozone degrading materials into the atmosphere.

Moreover the college observed National Sports Day to respect and encourage sport persons. It is more relevant for a state like Manipur which is known as Sport Power House of India. Nevertheless , National Science Day has been observed to enhance scientific temperament of the students particularly of science stream. The college screened Pariksa Pe Charcha Programmes (Jan 29 2019 & Jan 20 2020) to watch the interaction between Prime Minister and teachers along with students by gathering of this college. Students took keen interest in the observation of Teachers Day. In case Teachers Day could not be observed on 5th September due to collision with another occasion which could not be adjourned, it

had been held on another day recalling the significance of the building up of teachers students relationship. For example Teachers Day of 2019 was held on 13.09.2019 due to collision with the matches of Inter college Football Tournament, Manipur University,2019 hosted by this college.
