Yangambam Kumar College, Wangjing, Manipur was established as a co-educational private college on October 28, 1972 with affiliation to Gauhati University, Gauhati, Assam, under a private Management Committee comprising some leading local educationists and social workers of Wangjing, Lamding and adjoining villages of that time. (Late) Yangambam Biren (Babudhon) Singh of Wangjing AwangLeikai was the Founder Chairman of the management committee (governing body). The details of the erstwhile governing body were as under:

(Late) Y. Biren Singh, the Chairman of the committee was the main donor of the college and the present name of the college was adopted in memory of his brother, (Late) Yangambam Kumar Singh who died in a tragic aeroplane crash on way from Imphal to Gauhati in the year 1970. The college became a full-fledged government degree college with affiliation to Manipur University, Canchipur, Imphal, w.e.f. 01-01-1980 and got permanent affiliation status as per section 2(f) and 12(b) of the U.G.C. Acts. The college is at present preparing in full swing for assessment and accreditation by the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC), Bangalore.

ADMISSION PROCEDURE

Prescribed Application Forms (with Prospectus) for admission are available in the college office during office hours. Students willing to take admission in the college should apply on the prescribed forms which will be issued on payment of a sum of Rs.250/- (Rs.200/- in case of SC/ST candidates), as and when the notification of admission is officially served or it can be downloaded from the college website: www.ykcwangjing.com. The duly filled-in application forms should be submitted (online or offline) along with all the necessary documents on or before the last date of submission as notified. Admission Committee of the college will scrutinize all the submitted forms and selection will be done strictly on merit basis. Written test will be held as and when the necessity arises.

Eligibility for admission:

1. For B.A. (3 years under-graduate course): Should have passed the HSE Exam. in Arts stream from COHSEM, Imphal, Manipur or any other equivalent (10+2) examination from a recognized state/central/foreign Board or Council with 45% marks in the subjects concerned.



2. For B.Sc. (3 years under-graduate course) :

Should have passed the HSE Exam. in Science stream from COHSEM, Imphal, Manipur or any other equivalent (10+2) examination from arecog nized state/ central/ foreign Board or Council with 50% marks in the subjects concerned.

(N.B. Relaxation in the qualifying marks will be allowed as per provision of the government as well as per decision of the Admission Committee, as the case may be)

1. Copies of certificates and mark-sheets of HSLC (Class X) exam.

ELIGIBILITY TO APPEAR AT THE SEMESTER EXAMINATIONS

1. A student who completes a regular course of study for a complete semester in the college will be allowed to appear at the semester end examination conducted by Manipur University, provided his/her attendance of classes for all subjects, including practical, is not less than 75% of the actual lectures delivered in the subject.
2. Any student, if found to be enrolled simultaneously in any other college/institute will not be, at all, allowed to appear examinations of any semester in the name of Y.K. College.

PROMOTION: (AS PER ORDINANCE OF MANIPUR UNIVERSITY)

1. A student who has appeared at the 1st semester examination shall be allowed to attend 2nd semester classes of the college immediately after ending the examination and he/she will be allowed to appear the subsequent 2nd semester examination irrespective of any paper failed to pass in the 1st semester examination. He/she is allowed to reappear at the examination in the failed subject as back paper.
2. A student who has appeared at the 2nd semester examination shall be allowed to attend 3rd semester classes of the college immediately after ending the examination and he/she will be allowed to appear the subsequent 3rd semester examination irrespective of any paper failed to pass in the 1st and 2nd semester examinations. He/she is allowed to reappear at the examination in the failed subject as back paper.
3. A student who has appeared at the 3rd semester examination shall be allowed to attend 4th semester classes of the college immediately after ending the examination and he/she will be allowed to appear the subsequent 4th semester examination provided he/she has not more than four back papers in the previous semester examinations, taken all-together.
4. A student who has appeared at the 4th semester examination shall be allowed to attend 5th semester classes of the college immediately after ending the examination and he/she will be allowed to appear the subsequent 5th semester examination provided he/she has not more than four back papers in the previous semester examinations, taken all-together.

A student who has appeared at the 5th semester examination shall be allowed to attend 6th semester classes of the college immediately after ending the examination and he/she will be allowed to appear the subsequent 6th semester examination provided he/she has not more than four back papers in the 3rd, 4th, and 5th semester examinations, taken together.



RULES REGARDING DISCIPLINE
