## **Event Report: Day 2**

- 1. The programme started with the anchor inviting the Principal of the College, Dr. S. Giri Singh, K. Thoiba, Associate Professor & HOD, Department of Mathematics, Y. K. College and E. Surchandra, Assistant Professor & HOD, Department of Geography, Y. K. College on the dais.
- 2. Dr. Kh. Arundas, Assistant Professor, Department of Economics, Y. K. College gave an inspirational feedback of Day 1.
- 3. The session was started by Resource person, Dr. S, Sangrila Devi, Assistant Professor, DMCTE on the topic Adolescence. She gave a lecture on various dimensions concerning Adolescence period Counselling of students, emotional control, demerits of drug addiction, obeying parents, motivation to study, importance of time, personality development. From the lecture, the students learned to meet the challenges of life and achieve their full potential and develop social, ethical, emotional, physical and cognitive competencies. The lecture highlighted the importance of youth development programme for bringing common values of tolerance, understanding and mutual respect.
