A) *Title of the Practice*: Monetary Assistance for Boosting up Curricular and Extra Curricular activities of students and teachers

Objectives of the Practice:

The majority of the students in this institute belongs to poor families of rural areas since the institute itself resides in rural region and on another aspect, it can be assumed that sports loving students of the college are many who couldn't afford the necessities regarding their career development. At another area it can be stated that career of the teacher is also to be improved by participating in conference, seminar, workshops and various faculty development programs etc. for updates in their knowledge enhancement. Thus, to help in the progression of their curricular and extracurricular activities, the institution had introduced this practice from the academic year 2016-17 till date.

The Context:

It can be opined that there might be students who cannot pursue higher education due to poor economic condition of the family since most of the parents are poor farmer. Such case might be more frequent in rural areas where income earning facilities are scanty.

Since curricular and co-curricular activities are inseparable, such scenario is very obvious in case of rural areas of Manipur, which is known as Power house of sports in India in addition to its rich cultural heritage known worldwide.

The Practice:

The schemes included in this practice are as below:

- 1. Free Ship for Students of BPL Family: Exemption of either admission/ examination fee of students belonging to BPL family.
- **2. Financial Assistance to the Students of Poor Family**: Monetary assistance to the ailed student and his/her relative belonged to poor family.
- 3. Financial assistance to ailed teachers: Monetary help to teacher ailed during duty dedication.
- **4. Financial Assistance to Students Talented in Extra Curricular Activities**: For sports, culture etc.
- **5. Financial Help to Teachers Participated in FDPs**. Mainly for participation in seminar, conference and workshop.

Evidence of success:

The success of the practice can be predicted with the availability of beneficiaries of different schemes adopted.

a) Freeship for students of BPL family: In the year 2021-22, 30(thirty) students from various subjects and semesters have been benefitted through this scheme amounting to an expense of Rs.86,400/-. With the help of this benefit, the beneficiary students held from financially poor backgrounds have been able to admit and attend classes, and also appear in end-semester examinations.

b) Financial Assistance to Students of Poor Family

A teacher personally sponsored the following students during 2021-2022.

- In 2021, Puyam Johnson singh, 4th semester was given a mobile phone to attend online class during pandemic.
- In 2022, Rs. 3000/- for admission to 5th semester to Puyam Johnson singh.
- In 2022, Rs. 200/- for recharging mobile prepaid to Nongthombam Rejiya Devi, 5th Semester to attend online class.

c) Financial Assistance to Students Talented in Extra Curricular Activities

- In April 2022, Rs 5000/- was given to S. Boycha Singh a student of this institute from nongovernment account of the institute for participation in Inter University Games and Sports representing Manipur University.
